## Advancing Inclusive Digital Education: Highlights from the NERA2025 Conference

At the recent NERA2025 Conference in Helsinki, representatives from the University of Iceland — a partner in the Atollo project — presented research on the future of inclusive digital education. Anna Magnea Hreinsdóttir and Skúlína Hlíf Kjartansdóttir shared findings from *“Inclusive Digital Education for All? A Comparative Policy Analysis across Global, European, and National Levels.”*

The study, involving researchers from Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, and Norway, examined how digital tools are being used to foster inclusion in education, highlighting both global initiatives and national approaches. A key message was the need for more coherent policies to ensure inclusive digital education becomes a practical reality.
